

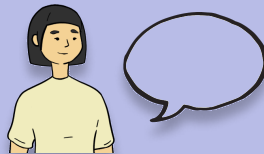
# What To Do If Your Pet Seizures

## Do



Ensure your pet is in a safe space: away from stairs, sharp objects and water such as pools and ponds

Talk to your pet calmly



Administer rectal Valium (Diazepam) if your veterinarian has dispensed this previously



Take a video of your pet during the episode. This information is vital for diagnosis/further treatment



Record the length of the episode, what the pet did before, during and after the episode



Call your veterinarian: inform them of the episode and make an appointment for a check up



## Don't



Do not panic

Avoid loud noises and bright lights



Do not touch you pet or try to pull the tongue out whilst seizing, you can get badly bitten!



Log your pet's seizures with Pets on tapp™ and share with your veterinarian
